"My rainforest home at Jaspers Brush is tucked at the base of the steep cliffs of the Illawarra escarpment. My daily physical engagement with the surrounding natural environment informs and shapes my work. Looking out across a vast sky to the distant Pacific Ocean I regularly record the weather patterns and the moving clouds. Richly furred Swamp Wallabies graze adjacent to my studio; lyrebirds frenetically call and silent wombats meander through the garden - a rich source of material to connect my work to the landscape and environment."

Anna Glynn is a contemporary Australian artist whose work draws upon a diversified practice incorporating: painting, drawing, moving image, animation, sculpture, installation, writing, music and sound. Her visually poetic work investigates the connection between humans, history, nature, land, place, physical and ephemeral. She has been recognised with numerous awards including the 2023 International Women's Day Arts Award and her work is held in esteemed public and private collections including: Australian Parliament House Art Collection, Canberra; National Museum of Australia Collection, Canberra; Shoalhaven City Art Collection, Art Gallery of Ballarat and the Kedumba Collection of Australian Drawings.
