My daily physical engagement with the surrounding natural environment informs and shapes my work. Looking out across a vast sky to the distant Pacific Ocean I regularly record the weather patterns and the moving clouds. Richly furred Swamp Wallabies graze adjacent to my studio; lyrebirds frenetically call and silent wombats meander through the garden - a rich source of material to connect my work to the landscape and environment."

Anna Glynn is a Dharawal based, contemporary Australian artist whose work draws upon a diversified practice incorporating: painting, drawing, moving image, animation, sculpture, installation, writing, music and sound. Her visually poetic work investigates the connection between humans, history, nature, land, place, physical and ephemeral. Her diverse practice includes: painting, drawing, video, sculpture, installation, photography, writing, music, sound and international interdisciplinary collaborations between art and science.
